By September 2023 we aim to meet the DfE expectation to provide a compulsory week of at least 32.5 hours.

Children should not be brought to school too early. The school day starts at 8:55 a.m.

Infant children are invited into school from the playground at 8.50 a.m. This enables parents to talk briefly to the class teacher should they wish to do so. Children will then be ready to begin learning at 9:00 a.m.

Junior children enter the school, grounds via the Junior gate and enter the school building from 8:50 a.m. and are collected and brought into school by members of staff.

All the children are then in school and ready to start work at 9.00 a.m.

Parents are requested to see that their children do not arrive more than ten minutes before 8.50 a.m., as there is no supervision of the playgrounds before morning school at 8:50 a.m.

Break Times

Infants am 10.30-10.45 pm 2.30-2.45

Juniors am 10.45-11.00 pm None

All Infant children can receive milk daily at a termly charge of £2. Children are entitled to free school milk if their family is on income support.

The Infant children receive fruit in school each break time.

Junior children are encouraged to bring a healthy snack.

Sweets and crisps are not allowed.

Children are encouraged to bring a water bottle into school, which they keep in class.

They can have a drink at anytime throughout the day. Parents take the water bottle home and refill it daily, or it can be filled in school. No flavoured water or juices are allowed.
